

10,000 ways to spend \$10,000

- Every K-6 grade level gets 1000 dollars (sped, title, and specials too)
- Meet with partner school to plan outdoor lab and get a sub for the teachers
- Grade essays for hs teachers
- Sub days—testing analysis
- Aide time to input test data
- Aides to make materials for teachers
- Pooling money from several schools and hire diagnostician for the schools for testing
- Hire someone to interpret test data.
- I2A release time to use data to drive instruction
- Hire someone to set up labs, etc. for science teachers (too tricky for kids to do)
- Printer in every classroom
- Para time increase
- Refocus room for kids and the para to supervise it
- Before/after school para time to help kids (tutoring, etc)
- Hire someone to read with kids-- retiree? Dogs?
- After school remediation program—pay teachers for their time
- Release time to build common assessments and grade them
- Plan more efficiently work with colleagues to work together more efficiently
- Roving sub to provide coverage for IEP meetings
- Invest money to have more later
- Hiring someone to do bully proofing, violence prevention—shared by several schools
- Hire someone to go to instructional leader meeting
- Response to intervention support—para etc.
